The Recovery Center offers

compassionate diagnosis and treatment of substance abuse problems for adults 18 and older. 24 hour medically supervised inpatient detoxification and extended residential recovery services provide a continuum of care in a safe and focused environment. It also provides integrated clinical expertise and care for those with co-occurring mental health diagnoses.

Fees

Fees for services are based on a sliding scale with income verification required. Private health insurance, Value Options, Medicaid and Medicare assignments are also accepted when applicable.

As a result of this inspection, CBHC's programs and services achieved the highest level of accreditation that can be received.
